#### New Business

- Full-Scale Exercise- LEPC needs to lead a Full Scale Exercise this year.
- LEPC Workshop- 2½ day conference in Athens, GA. Attended by approximately 80 people from more than 25 LEPC's across the state. The main concern of the LEPC's was the willingness to be more involved. Many areas were hosting training events, or safety days. This provided opportunities to branch out and create new connections, which helps with not only establishing relations with first responders, but also relationships with potential business clients. While private industry's goal may be profit, safety is everyone's responsibility, and should be a priority. Having an active LEPC provides a forum to discuss best practices in regards to safety, and reporting requirements. Chemical Facility Anti-Terrorism Standard (CFATS) implemented in 2007. Is this applicable to your facility? Google CFATS Appendix A to see if it is applicable to you. Contact DHS if you have questions on how this relates to your facility. LEPC Activity Guides with information from everything ranging from exercises to vulnerability assessments. Willingness to be proactive. And it starts right here at the local level.
- Commodity Flow Study- CEMA will be conducting numerous Commodity Flow Studies throughout Chatham County for the next several months. By conducting these studies, we will have a better sense of what kind of chemicals travel throughout the county, which in turn can aid in the planning effort to keep this community safe. All of this can be done at no cost, using a new application created by the Louisiana State Police.
- Hazmat Expo- 1 ½ day Hazmat Expo 2016- specific hazmat April/May. Grant money can be used.
